There will be a fair number of vendors presenting BMW specific original equipment and after market accessories. You'll have a chance to try motorcycle camping close to home, which is nice in case you discover you have all the wrong equipment. Even if you don't camp at Auburn, it'll give you a chance to look around and see what equipment other riders use and how they manage to pack it all on a motorcycle. Think of it as a practice run for this summer's trips and rallies. And believe it or not, I've been told that last year you could sit in the

Beer Garden, have a conversation in a somewhat normal voice, and listen to the music. That's quite a breakthrough in Rally planning. No guarantees, though.

Thinking of going to the Chief Joseph Rally in June? I'm planning on leaving very early June 17 and riding straight through, instead of taking the usual 2 day route through Eureka and Crater Lake. That makes about a 550 mile day. This will give me all day Friday to snoop around the John Day Fossil Beds National Monument. Why do you suppose as I get older I find fossils interesting? Anyway, I welcome anyone who would like to ride along. But I'm going to be moving right along at a fair clip, usually in the vicinity of the speed limit.

Thank you to all who decided to participate in the MOA mileage contest. I just mailed 30 entry forms and I know of at least 6 others who are mailing in their own forms. I believe that we only had 3 participants last year, so that is quite an improvement. Our participation alone should put the California entries up to about 90, still a little short of Wisconsin's 128 last year. But maybe some of the other California clubs decided to take up the challenge, too. If you haven't mailed yours in yet, it's not too late. Deadline is May 15. A member asked why we enter these mileage contests. I really didn't have an answer other than it give me another reason to: Ride Safe, Ride Often, Got Mufflers?

DAY RIDE FOR MAY (NOT TO BE CALLED A MAY DAY RIDE)

Can't decide whether to take in the Superbike Races or participate in the club ride May 1? You can do both. I've put together a ride that goes to Sears Point (almost) first, then to St Helena for a picnic at the V Sattui Vineyards. We'll all ride together to the Carneros Deli at the SR-12/SR-121/SR-116 intersection. From there it's a quick 11 miles South on SR-121 to Sears Point. GS Ride for Jimmy Lewis Wannabes

GS Ride, Saturday, May 8

There is a slight modification to the GS Ride. We will meet at the Flour Garden Bakery, next to Ralph's Supermarket at the corner of Brunswick and Sutton in Grass Valley at 10:00 AM. This means you can have breakfast with the club at WCP and still make the GS Ride at 10. To get there, take Hwy 49 north from Auburn. Exit at Brunswick to the right and make the first left on to Sutton or the second left into the Ralph's parking lot. The Flour Garden Bakery is to the left of Ralph's. The meeting point is about 1 hour from WCP. I will be there about 9AM for those that want to go direct to GV.

If you gas at WCP, you should be about right for fuel for the ride. If you fill in Grass Valley, 5 gallons total should be plenty, so don't completely fill it. All Adventure riders carrying 8 gallons will be left to pick up their bikes and fend off mountain lions on their own.

I hope to strike a balance with this ride. I have tried to make it doable for those that aren't aggressive off-road riders, and still keep it interesting for those with a little dirt experience. I also hope to stop here and there for some direct GS offloading instruction. The first half of the ride will be primarily scenic and about 80% dirt. We will have lunch at Casey's Place in Allegheny. After lunch there will be two options. The big-dog hard way is one,

which will return to Washington via 100% gnarly dirt, including a river crossing that was above my cylinder heads when I checked it out, or the easy way which will return to Nevada City via scenic routes of about 50% dirt. There are also numerous twisty paved roads if you've had enough dirt for the day.

You will need some skill to go on this ride, but I encourage anyone that wants to give it a try to come along. Most experienced street riders should be able to make it, although it is probably not passable on a pure street bike. I rode all but the worst part of the big-dog loop with my wife

and luggage on my R1150GS, so it isn't that bad (except for the two places where I boiled my rear brake fluid). You will also need a camera. I am fully prepared to stop and give any and all assistance where needed, including pushing, pulling, lifting and riding. So worst case is we have to stop here and there and help everybody through.
