WOW! That was a great rally up in Billings, Montana. Big Sky Country was every bit as beautiful as our advance scout (and lone member of RCB's Montana Chapter) Tom Moe promised it would be. We had 45 RCB'ers at the Rally! I may even have missed one or two others who never managed to check in at the Presidential tent or the RCB banner. As far as I can tell, the Minnesota BMW Riders with 51 attendees was the only club with more members at the Rally. I am not very confident that we will win the largest club award next year in Buffalo, New York, but I have high hopes for 2017 when the Rally will be held somewhere in the Pacific Time Zone.

Even though we lost to Minnesota for one award, we were not shut out entirely. Karl Weiland won one of the Grand Prizes at the closing ceremony on Saturday night and he now has \$1,500.00 worth of BMW apparel to select. 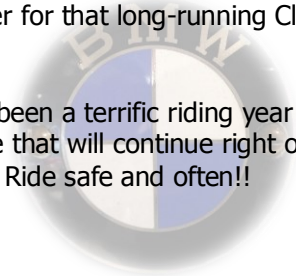

Editor's Saddle

Diversity in the Marketplace

We're constantly hearing about the rapid growth of ADV in North America, hopefully sending a clear message to the manufacturers that this ain't no fad we're dealing with.

The recent announcement of *Honda* bringing their new *Africa Twin* to the U.S. in 2016 is pivotal in that it's a large displacement enduro-oriented model from the *Big Four*. Unlike the more touring-focused *Yamaha Super Ténéré* and *Suzuki V-Strom 1000*, the new *Africa Twin* will feature highly sought-after sportier geometry—with more ground clearance and lower weight. *Honda's* new 1000cc parallel twin will depart from the *Africa Twin's* previous "V" configuration, bringing a more compact power plant, a short top tube, easy maintenance and cost efficient manufacturing.

Few details are available at the time of this writing, but we expect the *Africa Twin's* overall specs to be targeted at *KTM's 990* or *1190 Adventure*—at or below 500 lbs. wet with around 100 HP at the rear wheel. Word on the street is that some have already put their money down at dealerships for the first units. Likewise, we're looking forward to reporting on an initial test ride.

On the other end of the spectrum, *California Scooter Company's (CSC) RX-3 Cyclone 250* is an internet sensation with a boat load of pre-orders that proved it. Having already delivered their first units, *CSC* is doing a stand-up job providing excellent customer communication and support for a budget-friendly adventure bike for the masses. At less than \$3,500USD including crash bars and luggage, the *RX-3* begs the question of why similar bikes aren't available from mainstream manufacturers who also produce many of their smaller models in China.

Developments like these continue to bode well for the adventure market, not only in America, but around the world. Although as customers we sometimes wonder why it takes so long for our demands to be met, it's important to see our voice is growing and the industry is listening. What would your ideal adventure bike be?

Friday night, September 4th. Only then, will our next night's surprise destination be revealed with a Saturday Rally Route sheet that includes a MAIN STREET ROUTE (with a built-in WIN \$\$ Poker Run) and an optional GS LOOP. GPX files will be available for those using GPS.

BMW NorCal welcomes all women riders with our second annual Ladies Happy Hour on Friday night. Bring your Zumos and Navigators. Make sure your tires have plenty of sticky tread. Load your tents and camp chairs* and get ready

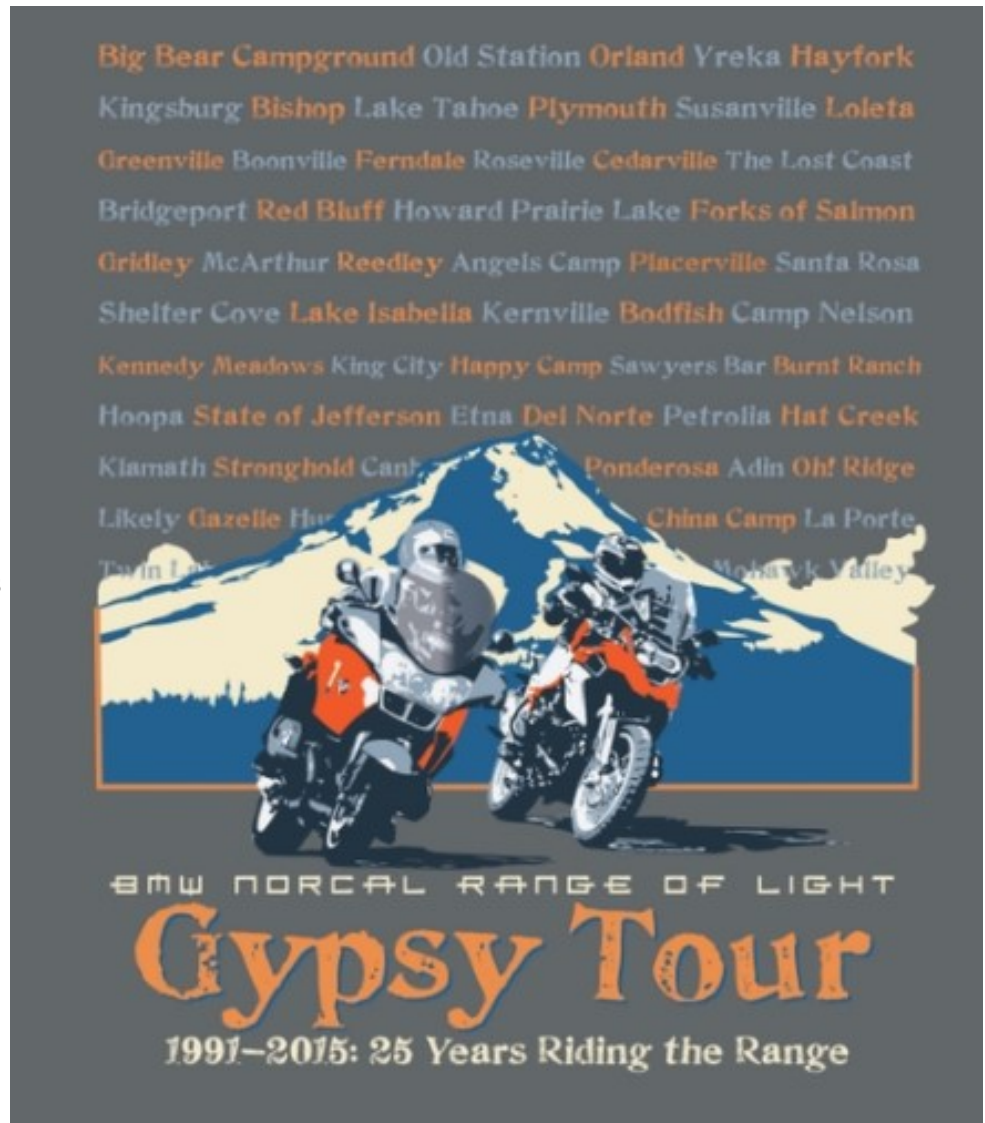

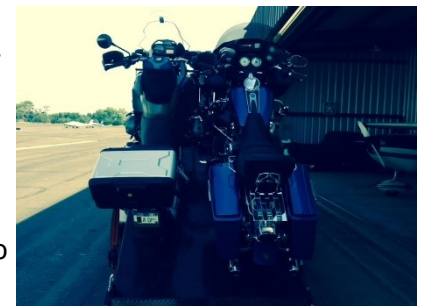

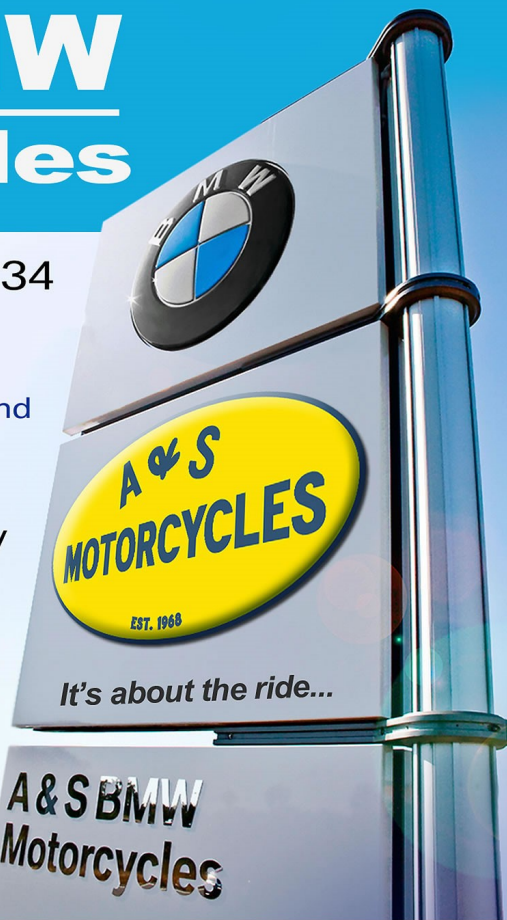
