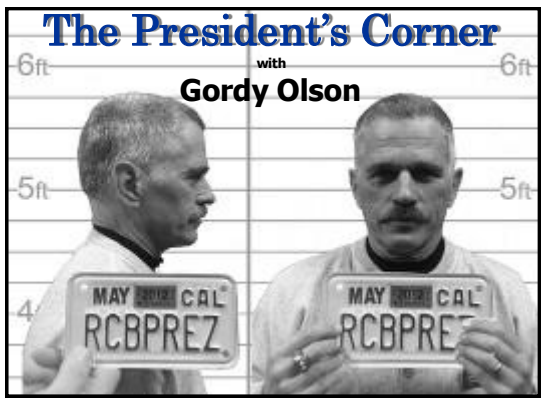

I know he won't be the last!

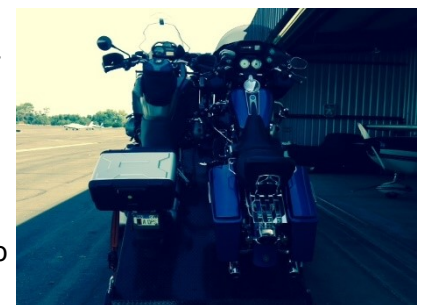

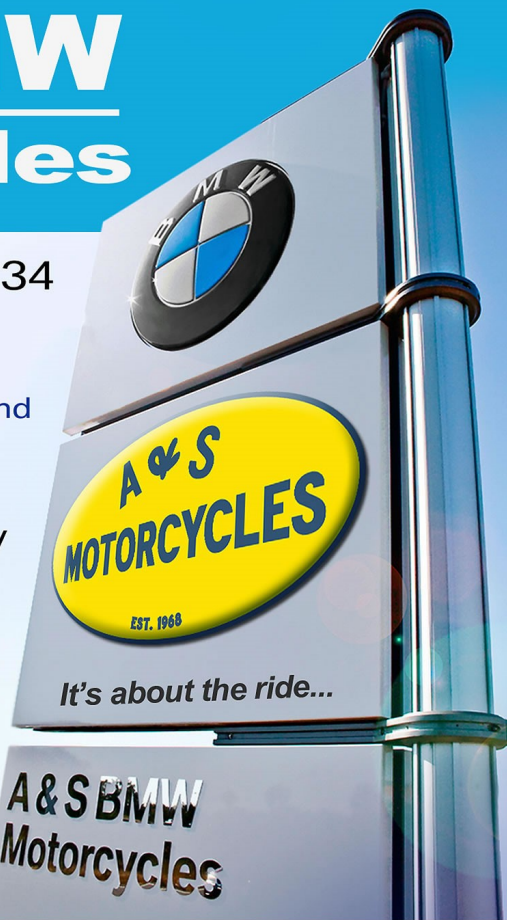
